

Terms and Conditions:

I am responsible for providing the correct, required information within the online entry form. By agreeing to these terms as the primary entrant, I agree to the event terms and conditions.

I am aware that photographs and video footage taken during the event may be used to publicise this event and the work of Cornwall Air Ambulance Trust ("CAAT"). I will let organisers know if I would rather not appear in photos/video.

I confirm I am healthy and fit enough to take part and if in doubt will contact my GP. CAAT will not be liable for any injuries, loss or damages connected with any part of this event. All participants taking part in an event do so at their own risk.

CAAT cannot be held responsible for any damage or loss to participant's personal belongings, items of clothing, shoes, equipment or vehicles for the duration of the event.

CAAT reserves the right to update their terms and conditions in relation to the event at any time or prior to the event day.

I agree to receive emails and postal mail regarding my participation in this event, including fundraising information, key event information and health and safety advice during the event itself.

I agree that I have a responsibility to ensure that all sponsorship money collected in respect of my fundraising efforts is paid directly to CAAT. If I am unable to take part in the event, all sponsorship money will be treated a donation, unless the donor requests the return of their sponsorship in which case individual donors must be contacted by the participant, who must then ask them to contact CAAT directly.

CAAT reserves the right to close registration when participant levels reach capacity.

CAAT reserves the right at any time to remove participants from the event who are acting negligently or without due care and attention for the event or other participants/staff/volunteers. Anyone removed under these circumstances will not be entitled to a refund of their registration fee or any donations.

CAAT reserves the right to cancel individual registrations or refuse entry to individuals, should there be a just cause.

Any changes made to the event will be communicated as soon as possible. Should the event date be changed, your registration will be automatically transferred to the new date or a refund offered on request.

The event organiser reserves the right to amend the event format or cancel the event due to circumstances beyond its control or for any safety reason.
