We are so delighted that you would like to raise funds for Cornwall Air Ambulance. Thank you so much for your support, we couldn't continue to provide this vital service without wonderful people like you! Your fundraising really will be the fuel that powers the helicopter on a lifesaving mission or the medical equipment that helps your Critical Care Paramedics deliver the best possible care to the most seriously sick and injured people in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly.

Your crew attend more than 1,000 missions every year and with no government funding, we rely on the generosity of amazing people like you to keep saving lives across our beautiful county. Every minute matters, and on average your helicopter is on scene within 12 minutes across mainland Cornwall, and in approximately 30 minutes on the Isles of Scilly.

Your Critical Care Paramedics are operational 19 hours a day, 365 days a year, with your AW169 helicopter and two rapid response vehicles.

YOUR FUNDRAISING RESOURCES

Having Cornwall Air Ambulance branding at your event will let people know who you're raising money for and where their donations will go.

Take a look at our resources available to download on our website. Your fundraising team are here to help with any top tips, advice, and any resources you require.

Collection jars & buckets

Having our official collection jars and buckets make people feel safer about donating their money.

Fundraising t-shirts/vests

We can provide you with branded sports t-shirts or vests so you can represent during your event!

Posters, banners & bunting

We can provide you with branded fundraising materials including posters, leaflets, banners, bunting and a totaliser to help you smash your fundraising target.

Sponsor forms

We can provide sponsor forms which include the name of your event and information for supporters about how to Gift Aid their donations.

Promoting your fundraising online

If you let us know the details of your event, we can advertise it on our event webpage for you.

For events that are in aid of Cornwall Air Ambulance, we can send you our official 'In Aid of' and/or 'Supporting' logos.

FUNDRAISING GUIDELINES

Collections

To collect in the street, you'll need a street collection license from Cornwall Council. To collect in a private space like a pub or shop, you'll need to ask permission from the business. Please ask us to borrow some of our official collection buckets and please do not open our jars or count the money yourself.

Health & Safety

If you are organising an event, you may need first aid cover or to inform the local police. You will need to do a risk assessment which will help you to assess any hazards.

Please also consider the safety and protection of children at your event, including requesting parental permission before taking any photographs. Always ask for copies of insurance certificates and DBS checks from suppliers where applicable.

Letters of authority

We can write you an official letter to prove that you are fundraising for Cornwall Air Ambulance. This will help you ask for raffle prizes. If you would like one of these, please get in touch.

Music, food & alcohol

If you plan on organising an event to fundraise, depending on the type of thing you want to do, you may need a licence. This is especially important if your event involves music or alcohol. Please check with the local council before you plan your event. If you are serving food in a public area, you will also need a food hygiene certificate.

Events including raffles

Raffles are a great way to raise money, and provided you sell the tickets and conduct the draw at your event, you won't need a license. If your raffle lasts longer than the duration of an event, there are strict rules that apply – call us for guidance.

As Cornwall Air Ambulance has its own lottery, we would ask you not to run a competing lottery.

Please let the team know how you are planning on paying in the money you've raised.


Online Giving Platforms
